After a successful trial in 2022, we will be opening our doors to guests in June 2023. We offer stays of up to 6 nights, Sunday to Friday. Guests can arrive from 4pm onwards on Sunday afternoon and departure is by 10am the following Saturday morning. Please note there is no parking on site, and guests are encouraged to use the train. Deal Station is less than 10 minutes' walk away.


There is no charge for the accommodation, although guests may make a contribution to our running costs. There is no obligation to do this.

## What is The small Society?

Our primary aim is to offer short-term respite for carers, particularly those who devote their time to supporting someone with a mental health disorder.

## Who do we help?

We provide residential breaks for anyone acting in the capacity as a carer, because we want to support those who look after others.





### What do The small Society provide?

We offer short breaks in two separate dwellings, each one accommodating up to two people sharing for a maximum of 6 nights. Both have bathroom facilities and a small kitchenette. The outdoor space is shared and there are plenty of places around the site to relax and unwind.



### Where is The small Society based?

The accommodation is in the centre of Deal, with the beach only a short 10 minute walk away. The town centre is even nearer with lots of independent shops, coffee shops and restaurants. There is easy bus and train access to Margate, Broadstairs, Ramsgate, Dover, Folkestone and Canterbury should you wish to wander afield.



# Accommodation

### The “Modern” Lodge

This is a purpose-built suite and has a large living area downstairs with a small kitchenette and an en-suite shower room. The bedroom is in a small mezzanine and is reached by climbing a ladder. If you would prefer, there is a sofa bed downstairs in the living area (both of the beds are doubles – 4 ft 6”). There are floor to ceiling windows in the living area allowing lots of natural light and views of the garden area and also a log burning stove in the main room.



### The “Rustic” Lodge

This is a former Summer House that has been extensively extended and modified. It is fully insulated and double glazed. There is a small deck out the front. The main living room has a sofa, a chair and a log burner. There is a small double bed (4 ft), and a kitchenette area. The toilet and shower are located in a building, 5 metres away. The summer house was previously used by the owner when the main house was being built. It has been completely refurbished since then to provide a cozy and welcoming environment.
